



The Art Contest Guidelines

- We first ask that all Art Teachers in FISD please publicize and promote this contest to all students. Only students in the FISD may participate.
- All student works for the Art portion should be **submitted by April 21, to Curtsinger Elementary**, contact is Laverne Forwalk. No late entries will be accepted.
- The theme for 2010 is **“Once Upon A Time... Exploring Our City’s Heritage Markers.”** There are over 20 heritage markers placed by the Heritage Association of Frisco throughout the City and we would like to see a student’s interpretation of any of the stories that these markers tell, which could be the people, the place, the event that occurred there back when, or what they see today. Heritage Markers may be found online under Projects at www.friscoheritage.org with additional support materials referenced online under Publications at www.friscoheritage.org, which then can be found at the Frisco Public Library and/or each School’s Library.
- Any medium may be used for the works, and works on standard 8½x11 duplication type paper need to be mounted on construction paper, at least. (The Heritage Association of Frisco doesn’t require matting; however, it does look nice when the art entries are matted.) The maximum size should not exceed is 2’x3’.
- Each school is required to submit a minimum of 10 entries with a maximum on 25 entries per school. If entries exceed the maximum number, Art Teachers and Schools will determine the 25 entries for the Heritage Association of Frisco’s final judging.
- One entry per student and all entries MUST be placed in a large folder or portfolio with the school name only clearly labeled on it and closed securely.
- The student’s name, grade, school name and Art Teacher’s name should be on the back of each art piece.
- A committee of knowledgeable judges selected by the Heritage Association of Frisco will judge the Art with winners to be revealed to Art Teachers in advance so students and families may make arrangements to attend the awards ceremony. Art Teachers are encouraged to attend as well as School Principals.
- Winning artwork will be displayed and seen on stage at the awards ceremony in **May (Date and Time TBD) at the City of Frisco’s Council Chambers**, at 6101 Frisco Square Blvd., and will last approximately 1 hour. The Heritage Associate of Frisco may also display entries at various locations, on website, in the press, and within the community.
- Each school, meeting entry qualifications, will have a cash award winner: Elementary – One Award winner will receive a \$25 cash award; Middle – a First Place winner at \$75 and a Second Place winner at \$50; High School – a First Place Winner of \$100 and a Second Place winner of \$75.
